Reading Suggestion: Exodus 1-16; Acts 7:17-45

Foreshadow focus: Moses foreshadowed Christ (Hebrews 3:1-6) as a prince-mediator of a covenant. The Passover foreshadowed Christ's death (I Corinthians 5:7, John 1:29). Israel's passing through water foreshadows baptism (I Corinthians 10:1-3). Wandering foreshadows our lives, and the Promised land foreshadows heaven (Hebrews 4:1-10).

1. Israel's bondage
 - a. Four generations/four hundred years in Egypt
 - b. Last 100 years - murder of the Hebrew male children
2. Moses
 - a. Prince of Egypt (Hebrews 11:23-26) for forty years
 - b. Midianite Shepherd for forty years
 - c. Leader of Israel for forty years
3. Exodus from Egypt
 - a. The Ten Plagues
 - b. The Passover night
4. Wanderings in the Wilderness
 - a. Condemned for not believing
 - b. Only two (& families) over 20 years old entered
