**Location**: Exodus - Deuteronomy **Reading Suggestion**: Exodus 1-16; Acts 7:17-45

**Overview**: Moses mediated a covenant between Israel and God on Mt. Sinai (Exodus 34:7, Deut. 29:1). This covenant included the law of Moses and the promise of the land of Canaan (Deut. 27:3). It was fulfilled with the death of Christ (Col. 2:14).

**Foreshadow focus**: Moses foreshadowed Christ (Hebrews 3:1-6) as a prince-mediator of a covenant. The Passover foreshadowed Christ's death (I Cor. 5:7, John 1:29). Israel's passing through water foreshadows baptism (I Cor. 10:1-3). Wandering foreshadows our lives, and the Promised land foreshadows heaven (Heb. 4:1-10).

  - b. Passover was not a worship day, it was a rest day
- 4. The Promised Land
  - a. Defined in Gen. 15:18-21
  - b. A conditional promise Deut. 28, esp. vs 63
  - c. Lost in the days of Jeremiah (19:1-11)
