- II. 1 Peter 1:15-16 As He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."
 - A. Originally, a command to the priests of Israel Lev. 11:44-45
 - B. Now it is a command to the Priesthood of Christ 2 Cor. 6:14-18
- III. Luke 6:36 "Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful."
 - A. In Matthew 5 it is said to be "perect"; is mercy perfection?
 - B. The merciful obtain mercy Matt. 5:7
 - C. The unmerciful are lost Matt. 18:28
- IV. John 15:9,12 "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you.. love one another as I have loved you"
 - A. Above all, the Father is loving.
 - B. we are to love as God has loved 1 John 4:7-21
 - C. Be steadfast as God is faithful to us
